

GISCorps volunteer to teach advanced GIS/Remote Sensing to faculty of Kabul Polytechnic University

This project is commissioned by [Kennesaw State University](#) (KSU) in Kennesaw, GA. KSU has been awarded a grant to establish a GIS program that includes furnishing two GIS labs and training the faculty at Kabul Polytechnic University. They are seeking the assistance of seasoned GIS educators to travel to Kabul for two weeks in summer of 2015 (July-August).

The teaching material will be furnished by Kennesaw University (and their partners) and will be provided to shortlisted volunteers.

This project is a follow-up to a class that was taught by two GISCorps volunteers in 2014. The subjects covered at 2014 training and those desired to be taught in 2015 are posted [in here](#).

Qualifications:

The desired volunteer must:

- Be an experienced GIS instructor who has taught not only advanced GIS technology and its use but more importantly its analysis capabilities;
- Have expertise and teaching experience in remote sensing;
- Experience in applying GIS in environmental science and urban planning is highly desired;
- Excellent verbal and written skills

Duration/Support: Please note that this position requires traveling to the region for **two (2) weeks**. The approximate time of travel is in summer of 2015 (July-August). KSU will cover the cost of travel, accommodations, meals, and insurance. More specific details regarding these items and all other important matters such as immunization, visa, etc. will be provided by KSU representatives.

Type of mission: this is an on-site mission. The volunteer must agree with and sign GISCorps' Release Form (http://www.giscorps.org/documents/Release_Form_sep08.pdf) prior to departure.
